Les Court grew up on a farm west of Pemberton, in the early 1920s. Left school at 12 to work on the farm. Became a sleeper cutter, then was a faller for State Sawmills in Pemberton. Worked in the Forests Department gang at Pimelia, near Pemberton. He was appointed as a mature age forest ranger, worked in Mundaring, then Pemberton. Became an Assistant Forester in Pemberton. Timber Inspector in Manjimup in 1970. Retired in mid 1970s. Champion log chopper. Had a champion racing dog in the 1930s. Father of Terry Court.
