



WEST AUSTRALIAN HEBERLE

FAMILY OF AUGUST FRIEDRICH and CAROLINE (nee Pabst) HEBERLE

Herman Heberle of NSW. Worked in or managed mines in Coolgardie and Bardoc WA from about 1894-99. Presumably his wife and some or all of his children accompanied him for all or part of this period. The WA goldrush commenced in late 1892 with the discovery of gold at Coolgardie.

Frederick Heberle of Victoria. In 1897 a Frederick Heberle was a Director at Broad Arrow Lease 963W, c37km N of Kalgoorlie WA. Possibly he was in the WA goldfields for some or all of the period 1894-99. Presumably his wife and some or all of his children accompanied him for all or part of this period.

August Frederick (August) Heberle b 22.7.1852 or 3.11.1852 South Australia, d 22.9.1925 Perth, buried Karrakatta W.A. Anglican FA 0137, m **Elizabeth Ann Datson** 6.4.1880 SA (nee Trathen, b 21.8.1850 d 26.9.1927, buried at Karrakatta WA, Anglican FA 0137, m John Datson 10.2.1866. Had 6 children by first marriage: Fred Datson b 20.1.1867; Fanny Datson b 21.4.1868, d 19.10.1940, married George West, lived in Albany at one stage, later had hotels in Perth; Willie Datson b 17.10.1869; Ernest Datson b 17.10.1872 d 27.4.1968; Minnie Datson b 11.7.1874 d 4.4.1896; Eliza Chalk Datson b 27.4.1876 d 12.12.1960 m E.Harwood. Lived at 7 Menzies St North Perth in 1927. Had 5 more children: Lilian E b 1880 Moonta SA, H Percy b 1882 SA (Moonta ?), Albert S b 1884 Moonta SA, Elsie E b 1885 SA

(Moonta ?), Leslie b 1889 Broken Hill NSW. Possibly had some training in medicine (Technical College?) and acted as a homeopath. Worked in SA c1866-85 then Broken Hill until 1898. In 1880-85 was a bootmaker, living in Robert St, Moonta (mining town) SA. Arrived in Fremantle from Adelaide 24.1.1898 on Steam Ship "Marloo" with wife and one child. Bought restaurant in Fitzgerald Terrace, Northam for Mrs Heberle to manage between 1898-1905 and house in Duke St. Lived at 1 & 28 Salvado Row, Wembley 1906-09. Farmed at Cuballing c1910-15. Had Hostel/cafe and lived at 495 Hay St on Irwin St corner, Perth c 1922-25. Had poultry farm just north of Benara Rd, Beechboro on east side of Bennett Brook, N of Perth in 1915-22. Lived at East Perth in 1925. Prospector, Kalgoorlie area c1898-1910.

Willie Datson Heberle b 17.10.1869. Adopted the surname of his stepfather during the Boer War, when living in South Africa from c1895. d c1940 South Africa. Married and had two daughters.

Arrived in Fremantle 4.3.1898 alone on Steam Ship "Wollowra" from Melbourne, aged 15, m **Mabel Eunice (Mollie) Lawrence** 1914 in Victoria, divorced 1928 ? (b 3.2.1890 Picton WA., d 4.12.1982 aged 92, buried Karrakatta Cremated, ashes not kept. Educated Girdlestone Girls School. She owned properties Cottesloe, S Perth, E Victoria Park. Lived at 222 Marmion St, Claremont (1924-28), 12 Garden St, Como (1930-34), "Woodlands" Gardiner St Como (c1932), 119 Lincoln St, Highgate (1935-36) and 55 Walcott St, Mt Lawley (1937-68+). m **Jessie Agnes** c1930 in NSW ? (b 29.4.1889 ? in Eastern States ? d 28.4.1975 aged 86, buried at Karrakatta Anglican PC 0436 unmarked grave. In 1938 at 2 Albans Ave, Mt Lawley, 1965-68 at 11 Wright St Highgate). Two children: Elsie G b 1915 Manly NSW, Harold L L b 1921 NSW ? d 1945. Educated at Scotch College Perth ? Had barber shop in Northam c 1898-1900 ? Worked as clerk for WA Government Railways at York 1901. In Geraldton 1909 ? Civil servant with parents Beechboro 1919 ? Lived away from WA much of the period 1915-1921 (Sydney and Melbourne?). Salesman in WA 1921. In 1925 lived with mother at 7 Menzies St, North Perth. In 1933-34 lived at 37 Weston St, Victoria Park. Accountant in 1938 living at 2 St Albans Ave Mt Lawley, with wife Jesse. In 1961-68 at 11 Wright St, Highgate WA. Built and operated school store in Normandy St, Inglewood at one stage. In 1968 at Sunset Home Nedlands WA.

Elsie Ernestine Heberle b 22.10.1885 Moonta? SA, d 21.9.1915. Died of tuberculosis at Woorooloo, buried at Karrakatta WA, Anglican GA 598. Went to Sacret Heart Convent, Mary St, Highgate. m William ? Gerloff c1911 Taught music, singing and painting. Music teacher in Brown St East Perth in 1910-11.

Leslie Heberle b 2.10.1889 in Broken Hill NSW, d Perth 1968. Arrived at Fremantle 24.1.1898 on Steam Ship "Marloo" with parents, m **Eva Elizabeth Furniss** 14.6.1910 Perth (b 9.11.1890 Bega NSW d 12.3.1976 aged 85, buried Karrakatta WA Anglican LD 0026. Worked for Peet and Co in Perth before married. She lived in South Perth, went to work by ferry). Interested in wildflowers. Had large collection of pressed wildflowers. Sold pressed and dried wildflowers in Perth during 1962 Empire Games period. Lived at 252 Hector St, Tuart Hill in 1965) d 15.2.1968 aged 78, buried at Karrakatta Anglican LD 0026. Had 7 children: Eva b 1911, Ron b 1913, Phyllis b 1915, Eric b 1917, Norm b 1919, Cyril b 1925, Harold b 1927. Went to school in Northam WA and Scotch College c1905-06? Trained (technical college ?) as fitter, turner, engineer. Lived at 121/122 Brown St East Perth in 1911-12. Owned garage on corner of Oswald St and Albany Highway, 57 Albany Highway, Victoria Park, Perth in c1915-1925. Lived nearby in various houses in Oswald St and Albany Highway (numbers 47, 57, 119) in 1915-25. Also had garage in Adelaide Terrace at one stage. Owned car assembling business (Singers etc) in Hay St Perth, which failed in the Depression c1930. Lived Lake St Perth, 1 Harrogate St (1926), 37 Harrogate St, Leederville (1928-29), then 1 Minnie St (1930), McCord St, West Leederville. Wife and daughters lived at 9 Connolly St, West Leederville (1935-36) and 13 Campbell St, West Perth (1938). Early in Depression (1930-32) fished at Furnisdale (Peel Inlet), then worked in Kalgoorlie (engineering workshop), living in hut in Egan St, Kalgoorlie. Fished in Esperance area 1932-34, lived in blacksmith's shop in Dempsters St (1932). Supplied fish to

goldfields. Also fished between Esperance and Hopetoun. By 1937 fished in Pallinup and Bremer Bay area and by 1938, when most of family shifted to Katanning, fished at Cape Riche and Doubtful Island area also. In 1941-45 lived in Piesse St, Katanning. Lived at 99 Beaufort St, Katanning between c1947 and c1964, supplied fish to towns around Katanning as Country Fish Supply. In 1965 at Broomehill Rd Katanning, shifted to Perth c1965 lived at 252 Hector St, Tuart Hill. Retired from active fishing in c1960, but Country Fish Supply partnership not dissolved until 24.1.1968.

Eva Ernestine Heberle b 21.12.1911 Perth WA, d 16.3.1940 Perth WA, buried at Karrakatta WA, Anglican LD 0026. Worked for Dr Hill in Rokeby Rd, Subiaco, then grocers shop in Cambridge St, Leederville. Also worked for Perth City Council and as a commercial artist. Died from bladder infection.

Ronald Leslie Heberle b 24.12.1913 Perth WA d 5.2.2004 Kingsley (Perth) WA, m **Pauline Emily Graham** 26.4.1946 Katanning WA (daughter of William and Thekla (nee Pustkuchen) Graham, b 20.2.1922 Narrogin WA d 20.12.2003 Perth WA. She educated at Narrogin (1yr) Geeralying (6yrs) Northam High (1yr) Bunbury High (2yrs) to Dec 1937. Worked in Richardsons variety stores in Katanning and Kojonup 1939-40 and on family farm near Narrogin 1941-42. Lived in Perth 1943-45, working at Perpetual Trustees. She played pennant tennis in Perth and represented State in hockey, selected for Australia 1946). He educated to year 8 at Victoria Park, James St, Perth Boys, Leederville, Thomas St and New Norcia. Left school in 1927 to work as messenger boy for bootshop, Eziwalkins, Tourist Bureau. Sacked in Depression (1930). Fished with father at Furnisdale in 1930-32 and went to Kalgoorlie with him in 1932. Fished with father and brother Eric in Esperance area from 1932. Later fished near Hopetoun also. By 1937 fishing in Pallinup, Bremer, Cape Riche areas. In 1938 based at Katanning. During World War II joined air force (6.7.1942). At Cunderdin May-August 1943, graduated as pilot at Geraldton 10.12.1943. Overseas 29.1.1944, back 30.12.1945, in England. Service terminated 4.3.1946. After war resumed fishing. Married 1946, lived Carew St Katanning 1946/47, 19 Cove St 1947/48 then 1 Bond St 1949 to 1958. Lived at 31 Admiral St Lockyer (Albany) Jan 1958- June? 1959. Lived at 62 (renumbered 78) Campbell Rd, Spencer Park (Albany) 1959-2001. Lived at unit 25, Craigville, 4 Kitchener Street, Melville 6156 since June 2001. Full time fisherman until 1968, then fished salmon seasons at Doubtful Island Bay and had other jobs in off season. Worked for Hunts Cannery field harvesting operations 1968-1973, Mayne Nickless carriers, also drove tip truck. Retired from fishing 1992. Interested in native orchids. Has written papers on and

attended conferences on orchids. Two orchids named after him, *Caladenia heberleana* "Heberles spider orchid" and *Diuris heberlei* "Heberles donkey orchid". Both grow near Albany.

Phyllis May Heberle b 6.9.1915 Perth WA d 21.10.2005, m Frank A. Merson 21.5.1938 Perth WA. Two daughters Margaret Ann (m Richard Herring, Children: Steven Bradley, Suzanne Margaret); Judith May (m Sven Svenson, Children: Ariana, Bohansen). Went to school in Victoria Park and Leederville. Worked as shop assistant for Foys in Perth. Lived at 75 Gregory St Wembley 1939-2001. Lived at Leighton Nursing Home, Florence St, North Perth July 2001-2005.

Eric William Heberle b 18.9.1917 Perth, d 27.2.2003 Perth, m Pearl Bain 1946 divorced 1951, m **Dorothy Florence (Doss) Hardingham** (nee Newland) 1980. (b 7.2.1916, d 30.6.2000 Perth. At Vinevale, West Swan Rd, Caversham in 1965). Eric went to school in Victoria Park, Newcastle St Leederville, then Thomas St West Perth. Worked as Blue cap messenger boy in 1931, for chicken farmer in Belmont, Wilson and Grey monumental masons at Karrakatta. Went to Kalgoorlie in 1932 and fished with father and brothers in Esperance area 1934-37. Worked on farm at Boyitup near Ravensthorpe ? during this period. In navy between 1939 and 1946, resumed fishing in 1947. Owned National Cafe in Katanning with Clarrie Daws until 1950, then built sheds around Katanning. Insurance agent living at 99 Beaufort St

Katanning in 1950-52. Managed poultry farm near corner Gnangara and Wanneroo Rds 1952-56, then worked for Waroona Abattoirs. Managed poultry farm for Diamond Ice at Wanneroo, then worked as chef in north west WA. at Barrow Island (WAPET) c1960-62, Marble Bar c1966, Rippon Hills (c1970), Telfer c1975-77. In 1961, labourer living at 161 Central Ave Inglewood WA. In 1965 cook at 12 Mile Camp M.R.D. Wyndham WA. Involved in tree growing and establishment at Telfer until retirement at age 60 years in 1977. Lived in Park St Subiaco, then lived in parents house at 252 Hector St, Tuart Hill in 1977-1980. Had big win with favourite numbers in 1980, purchased house in Hanworth St, Balcatta. Owned farmlet at Bullsbrook 80 km N of Perth, where he grew palms. Moved to this property August 2001.

Norman Alfred Heberle b 4.4.1919 Perth WA, d 9.11.1990 aged 71, buried at Gnowangerup WA, m **Violet Florence Quartermaine** 15.12.1945 Katanning WA (eldest daughter of Walter W and Jessie SF (nee Treloar) Quartermaine, b 2.8.1920 d 20.4.1991 aged 70, buried at Gnowangerup WA. From farming background. Parents farm 'Meanmahn'. Educated at St Josephs Convent and Government school Katanning. Good at sport. Club champion golfer at Forrest Hill Katanning 16 years in a row c 1959-74. Also champion some 8 times at Gnowangerup. Won club championships in bowls in Katanning and Gnowangerup. Also played hockey.

Upper Great Southern of WA. golf champion 1963. Worked as cook at Gnowangerup Hospital 1975-85). Children: Ian b 1947, Ross b 1948, Kevin b 1950, Alana b 1955. Went to school in Leederville until c1933. Worked for Good, Durant and Murrays clothes providers in c1934. Lived in Katanning from 1936. In army 1939-46. Fishing with other family members in 1946. Worked as cook in Strand Cafe in Katanning 1947, with Mobil Oil 1947-57. Lived at 7 Cobham St and Beaufort St, Katanning. Lived at 11 Carew St Katanning 1950-63, when he became manager of Katanning club in Amherst St. Went fishing with brother Ron in 1972. Shifted to Gnowangerup in c1974, worked on farms and WA Govt Railways. Farmhand living at "Clearhills" farm Gnowangerup in 1974-75 and at 7 House St, Gnowangerup 1975-91. Played football, cricket, golf, bowls. Inaugural captain of Wanderers football club in Katanning WA.

Cyril Ernest Heberle b 13.1.1925 Perth WA d 16.6.2004 Katanning WA, m **Margaret Ann (Peggie) Baxter** 11.9.1948 Katanning (b in Albany WA). Three children: Rosalene A, Malcolm L, Jennifer T. Cyril went to school Leederville, Kalgoorlie, Hopetoun, Lake Grace and Katanning Fished with other family members in Pallinup, Cape Riche, Bremer, Doubtful Is Bay areas between c1940 and c1947. Worked for carriers Old and Cornish in Katanning for about 11 years before buying and operating the business as CE Heberle & Co, carriers and wood merchant 1958-1978. Sold the carrier business in 1978 and worked for Katanning Shire as caretaker until retiring at 65 in 1990. Lived in flat in Bokerup St then 19 Cove St (1950-52), 23 Conroy St (1953-1966) then 89 Conroy St (1966-1996) in Katanning. In 1997-c2001 lived at unit 6, 66 Moreing St, Redcliffe 6106, Perth WA. In nursing home in Katanning 2001-2004.

He died or they divorced in 1942 ? in WA. She then married Harry Weeks, police constable, according to rmother's reference card in Battye Library Perth. Apparently died 1942 ? Not in WA ?

Harold Leonard Lawrence Heberle b 1921 NSW ? d 1945 accident NSW ? In NSW 1921, WA c1921-40 then NSW ? In army and navy in World War II. Changed name to Len Lawrence, after parents divorce. Married with 2 children: Faye Lawrence/Heberle ? and Graeme Lawrence/Heberle ?

Forester with Forests Dept at Manjimup 1968-69 (administration and inventory), Harvey 1970-76 (inventory & planning), Manjimup 1976-80 (district manager), Bunbury 1980-83 (regional planner), Manjimup 1983-87 (acting regional manager). Department name changed to Dept of Conservation and Land Management (CALM) in 1985. With CALM at Bunbury 1987-90 (departmental forest planner), Perth 1990-2001 (economics, forest resource planner, forest auditor).
