

10. HISTORY OF HEBERLES IN EUROPE

10.1 AUSTRIA (Major language: German) c13 Heberles 2001. Dr Erwin Heberle-Bors (b Germany, to Jakob Heberle of Rumania) has lived in Austria since about 1970. There have been Heberles in Austria in the past. Anton Heberle of Vienna was a music composer in the early 1800s. He wrote music for flute = recorder from 1807. Therese Heberle, a ballet dancer, was born in Vienna in 1805, possibly the daughter of Anton.

10.2 BELGIUM (Major languages French, Flemish) c3 Heberles 2001. There was at least one Heberle family in Seraing, Belgium in 1997.

10.3 CROATIA (Major language Croatian) c 2 Heberles 2001.

10.4 FRANCE (Major language French) c690 Heberles 2001. Benoit Heberle has compiled a very comprehensive genealogical database for the Heberles in France, with data for over 1000 Heberles, including dates of birth and death, addresses, occupations and family trees. Benoit has identified branches of the family originating in the following towns, as early as c1680, before which date the records are typically not available. The branches are: Lembach, Albe-Ville, Cleebourg, Dambach la Ville, Epfig, Falkwiller, Guebwiller, Hagenau, Neuf Brisach, Scheibenhard, Wintzenheim and others.

AIN (Central E France) c3 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Gex 1986.

ALPES DE HTE PROVENCE (SE, adjoins Italy) c7 Heberles (1996)

ALPES MARITIMES (SE coast, adjoins Italy) c10 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records I have seen are Cannes 1986.

ARDECHE (Central S of France) c3 Heberles (1996)

BOUCHES DU RHONE (S coast on Mediterranean, including Marseille) c19 Heberles 1996. First Heberles arrived around 1920, others arrived in 1960s from Algeria. Earliest Heberle records I have seen are Lascou 1968, Marseille 1975, Cannes 1986.

CHARENTE-MARITIME (SW coast, Bay of Biscay) c13 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Le Thou 1984.

CORSE (Corsica, Island S of France) c1 Heberle (1994) First Heberle arrived c1962, from Algeria.

COTES-DU-NORD (on English Channel) c3 Heberles (1996)

DOUBS (adjoins Switzerland) c7 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Audincourt 1956.

DROME (SE France) c13 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Montelimar 1963.

HAUTE GARONNE (S, adjoins Spain) c6 Heberles (1996) First Heberles possibly arrived c1950s. from Haut Rhin. Earliest records: Toulouse 1990.

HERAULT (S, on Mediterranean) c3 Heberles (1996)

ILLE ET VITAINE (Central W coast on English Channel) c3 Heberles (1996) First Heberles possibly arrived c1970 from Bas Rhin.

INDRE ET LOIRE (Central W, on Loire River) c16 Heberles (1996) First Heberles probably arrived c 1950. Earliest Heberle records Loches 1965, Tours 1969.

ISERE (SE France) c3 Heberles (1996)

LOIRE ATLANTIQUE (Central W coast) c3 Heberle (1996) Earliest Heberle record Nantes 1961.

LOIRET (Central N, on Loire River) c3 Heberles (1996))

LOT ET GARONNE (Central S) c3 Heberles (1996)

MEURTHE ET MOSELLE (NE adjoins Belgium) c19 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records Luneville 1862, Nancy 1928.

MOSELLE (NE adjoins Germany & Luxembourg) c85 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records Luneville 1862, Moulin les Metz 1927, Metz 1930, Dombasle 1933, Sommerviller 1933, Bussang 1940, Basse Ham 1952, Morsbach 1957, Yutz 1957, St Avold 1963, Vandoeuvre 1976.

NORD (N coast adjoins Belgium) c6 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Lomme 1991.

OISE (NW, near Paris) c6 Heberles (1996)

PUY DE DOME (Central France) c6 Heberles (1996)

BAS RHIN (NE, on Rhine adjoins Germany) c147 Heberles 1996. The Alsace and Lorraine area was part of the German (Holy Roman) Empire from around 1000, until about 1680, when it was taken by France. In 1871 it was annexed by Germany from

France, after the Franco-Prussian War, until returned to France in 1919, after World War I. About 95% of the Heberles living elsewhere in France are believed to have ancestors from the Alsace and Lorraine area. Probably there were very few Heberles elsewhere in France before about 1680. Heberles were probably present in Alsace in the 1500s but virtually all of the records before about 1600 have been destroyed. The earliest Heberle records I have seen are Dambach la Ville 1662*, Obernai 1685, Lembach 1690, Hagenau 1702, Epfig 1716, Albe 1718, Reichshoffen 1739, Cleebourg 1748, Ingolsheim 1800, Schwindratzheim 1801, Niedersteinbach 1805, Scheibenhard 1805, Windstein 1807, Wintzenheim 1820, Dambach 1820, Ebersheim 1826, Niederbronn 1826, Hochfelden 1839, Selestat 1845, Colmar 1859, Wissembourgh 1859, Holtzwihr 1868, Lauterbourg 1870, Soultzmatt 1870, Altenstadt 1892, Schiltigheim 1893, Brietenbach 1896. (*Heberlins present in 1621, changed name to Heberle by 1662).

HAUT RHIN (S of Bas Rhin, on Rhine adjoins Switzerland & Germany) c54 Heberles (1996) Part of Alsace and Lorraine. Earliest Heberle records I have seen are 1775 Orschwihr, Guebwiller 1790, Wintzenheim 1820, Falkwiller 1835, Siegolsheim 1847, Mulhouse 1861, Luneville 1862, Neuf Brisach 1878.

RHONE (Central France, including Lyon) c6 Heberles (1996)

HAUTE SAONE (NE, adjoins Bas Rhin) c13 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records Breuches 1986, Hauteville 1986.

SAVOIE (SE, adjoins Italy) c6 Heberles (1996)

PARIS (NW France) c29 Heberles (1996) First Heberles probably arrived after 1918. Some Heberles arrived from Albe, Dambach la Ville and Guebwiller in 1930s. Earliest records Paris 1924, Vincennes 1942, Eabonne 1969, Le Perreux sur Marne 1983, Mez syr Seine 1986, Les Lilas 1989.

SEINE ET MARNE (E of Paris) c3 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Nemours 1989.

YVELINES (W of Paris) c3 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record Mezy Sur Seine 1986.

TARN (S of France) c16 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records: Castres 1994.

VAR (SE coast on Mediterranean) c6 Heberles (1996)

VAUCLUSE (SE France) c3 Heberle (1996)

VENDEE (SW on Bay of Biscay) c13 Heberle (1996)

TERRITOIRE DE BELFORT (NE, adjoins Switzerland, Haut Rhin) c32 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records: Belfort 1905.

HAUTS DE SEINE (W of Paris, on Seine) c3 Heberles (1996)

SEINE SAINT DENIS (NE of Paris, on Seine) c3 Heberles (1996)

VAL DE MARNE (E of Paris) c16 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle records Vincennes 1942.

VAL D'OISE (N of Paris) c3 Heberles (1996)

VOSGES (NE, adjoins Haut Rhin) c13 Heberles (1996) Earliest Heberle record I have seen: Moussey 1989.

10.5 GERMANY (Major language: German) c1810 Heberles 2001. The Heberle family probably originated in "Germany" (Holy Roman Empire).

BADEN-WURTTENBURG (S.W. Germany adjoins Austria, Czech Republic) c350 Heberles (1996) Early Heberle records I have seen are Neenstetten 1602, Pullenreuth 1605, Kirchensittenbach c1609, Pommelbrunn 1625, Altusried 1682, Unterfinning c1725, Apfeldorf 1741, Miesau 1743, Gosserweiler 1743, Krumbach 1785, Lauben 1806, Lambrech 1827.

BERLIN (city State in N.E. Germany) c15 Heberles (1994)

BRANDENBURG (N.E. Germany, adjoins Poland and Berlin) nil Heberles in 1994 The earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1701 for Brandenburg city.

BREMEN (city State in N.W. Germany) c 15 Heberles (1996)

HAMBURG (city State in N.W. Germany, S. of Schleswig-Holstein) c35 Heberles (1996) The earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1877.

HESSE (Central Germany) c65 Heberles (1996) Early Heberle records I have are Kalden 1628, Heppenheim 1643, Hessbloch 1718, Bechtolsheim 1865, Planig 1881.

LOWER SAXONY (N.W. Germany adjoins Netherlands) c150 Heberles (1996) Early Heberle records include 1580 for Clausthal-Zellerfeld, 1796 for Diepolz, Unierte 1852, Unna 1869, Gelsenkirchen 1874.

MECKLENBURG-WEST POMERANIA (N.E.Germany on Baltic Sea) c6 Heberles (1996)

NORTH RHINE-WESTPHALIA (N.W. Germany adjoins Netherlands) c150 Heberles (1996) Early Heberle records I have seen are Mulheim an der Ruhr c1720, Burg Hemmerbach, 1792, Eitdorf 1794, Aachen 1802, Methler 1873.

RHINELAND-PALATINATE (W.Germany adjoins Belgium, Luxembg, France) c130 Heberles (1994) Early Heberle records include Lachen-Speyerdorf c1640, Muenchweiler c1669, Deidesheim c1690, Iggelheim c1694, Kaiserlauten 1703, Gossweiler c1723, Sippersfield 1728, Lambreken 1738, Lambsborn 1739, Winterbach 1740, Hoerd 1757, Trippstadt 1763, Laumersheim 1772, Landau 1777, Enkenbach 1778, Alsenborn 1799, Homberg 1800, Hochspeyer 1806, Frankenstein 1806, Albersweiler 1812, Steinwenden 1825, Germersheim 1838, Bruechen 1863.

SAARLAND (S.W. Germany adjoins France, Luxembourg) c5 Heberles (1994)

SAXONY (Central E. Germany adjoins Czech Republic) c20 Heberles (1994)

SCHLESWIG-HOLSTEIN (N. Germany adjoins Denmark) c5 Heberles (1994) Earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1700 for Rosenberg. (This could be Rosenberg in Baden-Wurt).

THURINGIA (Central Germany east of Hesse) c4 Heberles (1994) Early Heberle records I have seen are Scharzbach 1562 (may be a Heberer), Kulmstadt 1842.

10.6 HUNGARY One Heberle craftsman or shopkeeper was recorded from Baranyah, in Austria-Hungary, now Hungary, in the 1891 census.

10.7 NETHERLANDS (Major language Dutch) c36 Heberles 2001. Heberles may have been in the Netherlands since the 1600s but the earliest Heberle record I have seen is for 1796. I have some data showing that in 1947 there were at least 28 Heberles living in nine different cities in the Netherlands. At the present time there are some 36 Heberles in nine cities. At least one family migrated from Wurttemberg in Germany to the Netherlands around 1966.

GELDERLAND (E. Netherlands adjoins Germany) c6 Heberles (1994) Nil Heberles in 1947 ?

LIMBURG (S.E. Netherlands adjoins Germany) c3 Heberles (1994) One Heberle in 1947 ?

NORD BRABANT (S. Netherlands adjoins Belgium) c15 Heberles (1994) 17 Heberles in 1947. Heberles may have been in this area since the 1700s, after arriving from Germany, Alsace or Switzerland

UTRECHT (Central Netherlands, S. of Amsterdam) c6 Heberles (1994) Nil Heberles in 1947 ?

ZEELAND (S.W. Netherlands adjoins Belgium) c6 Heberles (1994) One Heberle in 1947. The earliest record I have for the Netherlands is of the death of Maria Sophia Heberle in Middleburg in 1796.

10.8 POLAND (Major language Polish) c3 Heberles 2001.

10.9 ROUMANIA c3 Heberles 2001. Heberles lived in Roumania (previously part of Austria-Hungary) in the past. Jakob Heberle lived in Jahrmakt, near Timisoara, in west Rumania, up until World War II. His ancestors migrated there in the late 1700s, from the Hunsruck area in Rhineland-Palatinate. Another Heberle family migrated from Mittelsbach in Rhineland-Palatinate in 1830 and settled in Liebling in west Rumania, where their descendants lived until 1944. In 1954, some of them migrated to Montreal in Canada, probably via Germany. Two Heberle craftsmen or shop keepers were recorded from Temes, in Austria-Hungary, now Roumania, in the 1891 census. In March 1999, Denis Heberle was the Deuxieme Secretaire to the French Ambassador, in Bucharest, Roumania.

10.10 SLOVENIA (formerly part of Yugoslavia) (Major languages: Slovenian, Croatian) c70 Heberles 2001. The Slovenian Heberles are thought to be of German ancestry but might have migrated via other nations, such as Austria-Hungary. Six Heberles are believed to have arrived in Slovenia (Jereko) from Tirol (Austria) in 1911.. At least 6 Heberle families lived in the capital, Ljubljana, in 1998.

10.11 SLOVAKIA (formerly part of Austria-Hungary) One Heberle craftsman or shop keeper was recorded from Szepes, in Hungary, now Slovakia, in the 1891 census.

10.12 SPAIN (Major language: Spanish) c3 Heberles 2001. Moacir Heberle of Brazil advised on 10.6.1997 that his brother Gastao lived in Ibiza, Spain. Weiler G Heberle lived in San Jose in 1998.

10.13 SWEDEN (Major language: Swedish) c2 Heberles 2001 About 10 Heberles from the Clausthal-Zellerfeld branch lived in Sweden in the 1880s-1890s, including Ernst August Heberle and brother Josef. (Wieselgren and Hildebrand, 1946). Josef died in Sala in 1912. A few Heberles have lived in Sweden in recent years.

10.14 SWITZERLAND (Major languages: German, French, Italian) c36 Heberles 2001. According to World book data there are approximately 36 Heberles in Switzerland today. Much more common are the Haeberli and Haeberlin families which can be traced back to at least 1341. There were possibly more Heberles in Switzerland in the past. Some Heberles are thought to have moved from Switzerland to France after the 30 years war (1618-1648). The earliest Heberle records I have seen are Amrisil (Thurgau) 1623, Zurich 1916, Tablat 1939, Gerlikon 1947.

10.15 UNITED KINGDOM (Major language: English) c4 Heberles 2001. According to Burke's Peerage data, no Heberles lived in England, Scotland, Wales or Ireland in 1994. Heberles have lived there temporarily during World War II and for study. Heberley and Habberley family members lived here in the 1800s and some migrated to New Zealand (and U.S.A.?). Heberley could be Heberle anglicised. Albert Heberle (of Germany) was at Cambridge University during 1996-2000. Patricia Heberle from Australia is currently the England womens hockey coach.

10.16 UKRAINE (formerly part of Russia, USSR) (Major language: Ukrainian) c3 Heberles 2001. Internet data shows that some Heberles (maybe 20) and numerous Hepperles (over 100) lived in Ukraine in the 1840-1914 period. Andreas Heberle from Alpirtsbach, Wurttemberg, migrated to Ukraine c1840. His decendants (at least 12) lived near Odessa until 1945. At the end of World War II they were forced to move further east, to Siberia, Kasakhstan, Tadjikistan, Usbekistan. Frederick Heberle b 1841, wife Barbara b 1843 and children, immigrated to Campbell County, South Dakota USA in 1898, from Ukraine, probably from the Gueldendorf area, 16 km NNE of Odessa. Some other Heberles migrated to USA 1890 onwards. Internet data shows that John Heberle (from USA ?) lived in Kyiv, Ukraine in 1996.

10.17 OTHER NATIONS

Northern Europe The Haber group of surnames occur in Denmark and Finland but no Heberles that I know of.

Eastern Europe Before 1945, Heberles lived in parts of **Lithuania and Russia**, which were once part of Germany, or Austria-Hungary. Rudolf Heberle (migrated to USA) lived in Lithuania in 1921 and in Konigsberg, East Prussia in 1923-26 (now Kaliningrad, Russia). Ivana Heberleinova lived in Praha, in the Czech republic in 1994.

Southern Europe Therese Heberle, the ballet dancer from Austria, died in Naples, **Italy** in 1840. There could be some Heberles in Italy at present. One Heberle was born in Cordenons, Italy in 1904. There are some Haberles in Serbia, but no Heberles that I know of. Jean-Claude Heberle of France was in Monte Carlo, **Monaco** 1981-84.

11. HISTORY OF HEBERLES IN AMERICA

11.1 ARGENTINA (Major language: Spanish) c18 Heberles 2001. Juan Heberle migrated here from Brazil in 1936. Most of the Argentine Heberles are descended from him. Aldayr Heberle of Brazil was in Buenos Aires 1979-82 and 1989-90.

CORDOBA Province (Central Argentina, NW of Buenos Aires) c3 Heberles (1997)

LA PAMPA Province (Central Argentina, SW of Buenos Aires) c3 Heberles (1997)

MISIONES Province (NE Argentina, adjoining Brazil) c6 Heberles (1997)

11.2 BRAZIL (Major language: Portuguese) c400 Heberles 2001. Between 1835 and 1914, some 120,000 Germans migrated to Brazil (mainly to the south-east), including at least one Heberle family: Johann Heberle b 1793 in Berus Saarland, Germany, migrated Sept 1828 with wife Johanna and four children (Elisabeth b 1816, Nicolau b 1818, Pedro b 1820, Joao b 1824) on the "Olbers" and arrived in Rio de Janeiro 17.12.1828, before settling in Dois Irmaos, near Sao Leopoldo, Rio Grande do Sul State in March 1829. The family settled in Dois Irmaos, Rio Grande do Sul State, in 1829. Johann died there in 1866, but some of his family, including Pedro Heberle (I) moved to Estrela in about 1856. Pedro's son Pedro (II) had 17 children by 2 wives, in Estrela. Various descendents moved to Bom Retiro do Sul and Cruzeiro do Sul in the early 1900s and Porto Alegre, Roca Salles and Lajeado within Rio Grande do Sul State, during the 1930s. Other descendents probably moved into other southern Brazilian states, during the early to mid 1800s. Johannes Ebri/Ebli (b c1815 Germany) migrated to Brazil c1840. His descendents live in Brazil. Franz Joseph Heberle b 1880 Ulm (Rottenburg branch) migrated to Brazil c1920.

PARANA (S.E. coast of Brazil) c25 Heberles (2000) First Heberles possibly arrived in early to mid 1900s.

RIO GRANDE DO SUL (Most S. State of Brazil, on coast) c290 Heberles (2000) Earliest Heberle records I have seen are Dois Irmaos 1829, Estrela 1856, Sao Leopoldo 1857, Bom Retiro do Sul 1903, Cruzeiro do Sul 1909, Porto Alegre 1931, Roca Salles 1938, Lajeado 1939, Guaiba 1985.

SANTA CATARINA (S.E. coast of Brazil, N of Rio Grande do Sul) c65 Heberles (2000) The earliest Heberle records I have seen, are Rio Pardo 1927 and Joacaba 1966.

SAO PAULO (S.E. coast of Brazil, N. of Parana) c10 Heberles (2000) First Heberles possibly arrived in early to mid 1900s.

11.3 CANADA (Major languages: English, French) c17 Heberles 2001. John F Heberlee was born 11.12.1825 in Canada, possibly to a Mr and Mrs Heberle. His son, born in Sturgis, Michigan in 1825 spelt his name Hebrlee. Daniel Häberle (b 7.4.1826 Wansingen, Wurttemberg, Germany) arrived in Canada in 1852 and settled initially in Rainham, Ontario, then Mildmay. His 9 children and their descendents used the name Heberle (Merritt, 1954). Johann Heberle (b 1904 Liebling Austria-Hungary, later Rumania) and family migrated to Montreal in 1954, having left Liebling in 1944.

ONTARIO c7 Heberles (1994) First Heberles arrived 1851, from Germany. Earliest Heberle records I have seen are 1851 for Rainham, Mildmay 1860, 1887 for Aldborough, 1890 for Rodney, 1920 for Toronto.

QUEBEC c7 Heberles (1994) First Heberles possibly arrived since 1930, from Europe.

11.4 CHILE (Major language: Spanish) c1 Heberles 2001. Cecilia Heberle was a Representante legal with Productos Austral S.A. in Santiago in 1998.

11.5 COLOMBIA (Major language: Spanish) c3 Heberles 2001.

Karl Heinz Heberle Sampayo Gerente works for PAFIC in Santa Fe De Bogota. They sell general food and beverages.

11.6 MEXICO (Major language: Spanish) c5 Heberles 2001. Milton Heberle and family, from Brazil, live in Merida, Mexico.

11.7 UNITED STATES OF AMERICA (Major language: English) c715 Heberles 2001. My guess is that at least 250 Heberles have migrated to U.S.A. from Germany, France, the Netherlands, Switzerland, Austria, Hungary and Croatia, since about 1750. Most of the Heberle immigrants probably arrived in U.S.A. during the period 1830-1900, (perhaps 150 Heberles) when almost 5,000,000 Germanic peoples migrated to North America. Heberle migrations to North America that I am aware of are as follows:

- Phillip Heberle (wife Maria) settled in New York before 1799. Religion was Dutch Reformed Church.
- Tobias Heberle (b June 1795) from Wurttemberg, settled in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania circa 1810, later moved to Colubiana County Ohio and then to Wayne County Ohio. By 1850 his descendants were spelling the surname as Heberly.
- **Casper Heberle**, brother Peter and son Joseph Heberle, from Lauderbach in Baden, arrived in Rochester, New York in 1832. Casper moved to Ohio in about 1850.
- **Peter Heberle** b 1799 Sulzbach, Baden, wife Anna, Mary b 1823, John b 1825, Katharina b 1827, Adam b 1830, Antony b 1833, Margaret b 1835, Jacob b 1837, Philip b 1839, Elizabeth b 1841; arrived in USA 1843.
- The bark "Dyle Sooms" arrived in Galveston from Antwerp in January 1846, with Gottlieb Heberle (farmer, b 1822 Germany) on board. He settled in Texas.
- Susanna Heberle, labourer, b 1830 Germany arrived New York 22.5.1850, on the "Actress".
- **Stanislaus Heberle** (b 11.11.1826), wife Margaret and son Alois b 1874, from Rottenburg arrived in New York in June 1851, settled in Goshen Indiana in 1852 and then moved to Henderson Minnesota in 1856.
- **Mathias Heberle** b Dambach 1824 arrived in New Orleans 19.3.1852 from Alsace in France.
- Christian Heberle, farmer b 1835 Wurttemberg, arrived in New York 1.4.1852 on the "Schiller".
- Joseph Heberle b Bitschwiller 1832 arrived in New York 3.4.1852 from Alsace in France.
- **Martin Heberle** b 1828 Germany, arrived in USA date unknown (possibly c1855) and settled in Dayton Ohio.
- Frederick C Heberle (b 1834) arrived in 1852 and settled in Baltimore MD.
- Mr. S. Heberle b 1828 Schwarzburg ? arrived in New York 29.5.1852 on the "Duchesse D'Orleans".

ARIZONA (S.W. USA adjoins Mexico) c7 Heberles (1996) U.S. territory since 1863, State since 1911. First Heberles probably arrived after 1980.

CALIFORNIA (S.W. coast of USA adjoins Mexico) c60 Heberles (1996) U.S. State since 1850. Gold rushes 1848. First Heberles probably arrived before 1850. Heberles moved here from Illinois, Minnesota and Wisconsin in 1930s-1960s.

COLORADO (Central USA NW of Texas) c5 Heberles 1996. First Heberles probably arrived by 1900.

CONNECTICUT (N.E. coast, N.E. of New York) c7 Heberles (1996) First settled by Dutch and English (from Massachusetts) in 1633. Earliest Heberle birth record 1850.

DELAWARE (Central E. coast, S of Pennsylvania) c3 Heberles (1996) First Heberles arrived before 1920.

FLORIDA (S.E. coast) c55 Heberles (1996) Colonised by France and Spain 1540-1560s. Ceded to USA 1821. U.S. State 1845. First Heberles possibly arrived before 1890. Heberles moved here from Pennsylvania and New York in 1950s-1960s.

GEORGIA (S.E. coast, N. of Florida) c6 Heberles (1996) Colonised by Spain 1560s. English settlers arrived 1733. No Heberles until 1990s ?

ILLINOIS (Central E., S. of Great Lakes) c9 Heberles (1996) Colonised by France 1673. U.S. Territory 1809, State 1818. First Heberles probably settled after 1850.

INDIANA (Central E., S. of Great Lakes) c4 Heberles (1996) Colonised by France 1732. U.S. State 1816. First Heberles probably settled in early 1850s. The earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1852 for Goshen.

IOWA (Central USA, W of Great Lakes) No Heberles (1996) Heberles lived here from 1890s ?

KENTUCKY (Central E., S. of Indiana) c4 Heberles (1996). Settled by British 1774. U.S. State 1792. First Heberles probably

arrived in 1850s.

LOUISIANA (S. coast, to E. of Texas) c9 Heberles (1996) Colonised by France 1714. Purchased by USA 1803. U.S. State 1812. First Heberles may have settled in 1860s.

MAINE (N.E. coast adjoins Canada) c4 Heberles (1996) Settled by British 1622. First Heberles possibly arrived 1980s.

MARYLAND (N.E. coast, E. of Washington D.C.) c24 Heberles (1996) Settled by British 1632. First Heberles possibly settled during 1850s.

MASSACHUSETTS (N.E. coast, N.E. of New York city) c9 Heberles (1996) Settled by British 1629. First Heberles possibly settled during 1880s. Earliest birth record 1877.

MICHIGAN (N.E. inland adjoins Great Lakes) c4 Heberles (1996) Colonised by France 1668. Ceded to British 1763. U.S. State 1837. First Heberles possibly arrived after 1890. Earliest Heberle birth record I have seen is for 1896.

MINNESOTA (Central N., W. of Great Lakes) c6 Heberles (1996) Settled by U.S. 1837. U.S. State 1858. Earliest Heberle records I have seen are for Henderson in 1856.

MISSOURI (Central USA, N.E. of Texas) c57 Heberles (1996) Colonised by France 1735. Purchased by U.S. 1803. U.S. State 1821. First Heberles probably arrived in 1840s. The earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1845 for St Genevieve.

MONTANA (N.W. of USA adjoins Canada) c70 Heberles (1996) Purchased by U.S. from France 1803. Settled by U.S. 1807. U.S. State 1859. First Heberles possibly settled in 1910s.

NEW JERSEY (N.E. coast, S.W. of New York city) c4 Heberles (1996) Colonised by the Dutch c 1623. British colony 1664. First Heberles probably arrived in 1850s. The earliest Heberle records I have seen is 1860 for Newark.

NEW YORK (N.E. coast adjoins Canada) c130 Heberles (1996) Colonised by Dutch 1623. Seized by British 1664. First Heberles possibly arrived in 1790s. The earliest 1992 IGI record is of the christening of Margretha Heberle (father Phillip, mother Maria) in the Dutch Reformed Church in New York in 1799.

NORTH CAROLINA (Central E. coast) c13 Heberles (1996) Settled by the British 1587. First Heberles possibly arrived in 1980s.

NORTH DAKOTA (Central N. of USA adjoins Canada) c4 Heberles (1996) First British settlement 1812. First Heberles possibly arrived this century. Earliest birth record 1926. OHIO (Central N. adjoins Great Lakes) c18 Heberles (1996) First U.S. settlement 1788. U.S. State 1803. First Heberles probably arrived in the 1850s. The earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1859 for Ruffra.

OREGON (N.W. of USA, N of California) c2 Heberles (1996). Earliest Heberle possibly arrived in 1890s.

PENNSYLVANIA (N.E. of USA, W. of New York) c110 Heberles (1996) Settled by British 1681. First Heberles possibly arrived in 1760s. The earliest Heberle records I have seen is 1766 for Lehigh Whitehall.

SOUTH CAROLINA (S of E coast) c2 Heberles (1994). First Heberlers possibly arrived in 1980s.

SOUTH DAKOTA (Central N of USA) nil Heberles 1996 Earliest Heberle record I have seen is 1898 for Campbell county.

TENNESSEE (SE of USA) c7 Heberles (1996). First Heberles possibly arrived in 1850s.

TEXAS (Central S. of USA, adjoins Mexico) c24 Heberles (1996) Settled by Spain 1682. U.S. State 1845. First Heberles possibly arrived during 1840s.

VIRGINIA (Central.E. coast of USA) c30 Heberles (1996) Settled by British 1607. First Heberles possibly arrived in 1830s.

WASHINGTON District of Columbia (between Maryland and Virginia, N.E. USA) nil Heberles 1994 Heberles lived in Washington by 1863.

WASHINGTON STATE (N.E. coast of USA, adjoins Canada) c6 Heberles (1996) Colonised by British 1810. U.S. State 1889. First Heberles possibly arrived after 1890.

WISCONSIN (Central N. of USA, adjoins Great Lakes) c3 Heberles (1996) Settled by France 1701. Taken over by USA 1783. U.S. State 1848. First Heberles possibly arrived in 1850s.

WYOMING (Central USA, S of Montana) c7 Heberles (1996).

11.8 OTHER AMERICAN NATIONS Heberles could be present in nations such as Paraguay (inland from southern Brazil) and Uruguay (between Argentina and Brazil). There are Heberles and Heberles in Chile, Haerberles in Peru and Hebers and Habers in Paraguay.

12. HISTORY OF HEBERLES IN AFRICA

12.1 ALGERIA (Major languages: Arabic, Berber, French) Some Heberles from Alsace went to Algeria in 1871, where their

descendants lived until Algeria won its independence in 1962. They were then repatriated to France. Jean-Claude Heberle, a well known journalist, was born in 1935 in the city of Constantine in the north east of Algeria. He lived in Algeria until 1961. The number of Heberles in Algeria may have reached a maximum of about 20. The earliest Heberle records I have seen are Blida 1955, Boghari 1943, Constantine 1879, Mostagnem 1940, Philippeville 1875, Saïda 1957. There are no Heberles living in Algeria today.

12.2 CAMEROON (Major languages: Fang, Bamileke, Fulani, Duala, French, English) Laurent Heberle b 1907 in Alsace (?), was a Catholic missionary in Cameroon 1934-1959. He wrote a book under the name of J. Gilles Heberle, about the Catholic missions in the Cameroon, which was published in 1960. He was assassinated by guerilla fighters in 1959. Brigitte Heberle was born in Douala in Cameroon in 1951 (her father is Etienne C.Heberle). There has probably been no Heberles living in Cameroon since 1959.

12.3 GUINEA (Major languages: Fulani, Mandingo, Susu, French) Marie T Heberle was born in Conakry in Guinea in 1950 (her father is Etienne C.Heberle). There has probably been no Heberles living in Guinea since 1951.

12.4 SOUTH AFRICA (Major languages: Afrikaans, English, Xhosa, Zulu, Sesotho) There are no Heberles in South Africa today, according to Burke's Peerage database. One Heberle family was in South Africa c1895-c1940. This was the family of Willie (Datsun) Heberle from West Australia.

12.5 ST HELENA (Major language: English) At least one Heberle lived in St Helena in 2002.

12.6 OTHER AFRICAN NATIONS There could have been and might still be Heberles in former German colonies such as South-West Africa (Namibia), and former French colonies in Africa or nearby islands such as Mauritius.

13. HISTORY OF HEBERLES IN ASIA

13.0 USSR Descendants of Andreas Heberle (who migrated to Ukraine in c1840), lived in Ukraine until 1945. At the end of World War II, they were forced to move further east.

13.1 KASAKHSTAN (NW of China, SW of Siberia) About 20 descendants of Andreas Heberle lived in Kasakhstan c1948 to 1997.

13.2 SIBERIA (NE USSR) c2 Heberles 1998. About 6 descendants of Andreas Heberle lived in Siberia c1945 to 1998.

13.3 TADGIKISTAN (N of Afghanistan and Pakistan) About 13 descendants of Andreas Heberle lived in Tadgikistan c1951 to 1990.

13.4 USBEKISTAN (S of Kasakhstan) Some of Andreas Heberle's descendants livesd in Usbekistan in the 1950-1990 period.

13.5 JAPAN At least one Heberle family (from France) lived in Japan in 2001.

13.6 KUWAIT At least one Heberle lived in Kuwait in 2002.

13.7 ELSEWHERE IN ASIA Heberles could have lived in French colonies in Asia. There could be Heberles in Israel.

14. HISTORY OF HEBERLES IN OCEANIA

14.1 AUSTRALIA (Major language: English) c55 Heberles 2001. It is believed that six Heberle families or individuals have migrated to Australia, all from Germany. They are: August F Heberle (b 1812), wife Caroline and 5 sons from Clausthal-Zellerfeld (Carl AW b 1838, Carl AC b 1840, Carl AH b 1846, Friedrich b 1849, Carl b 1851) arrived in Adelaide South Australia 21.9.1851 on the "Herder". Frederick L Heberle (b 1810, brother of August F), wife Carol and 4 children (Augusta b 1835, Heinrich b 1837, Johanne b 1841, Wilhelm b 1848), from Clausthal-Zellerfeld, arrived in Adelaide South Australia 2.1.1855 on the "Johan Cesar". Carl August Frederick Heberle (b 1837) from Clausthal-Zellerfeld, arrived in Victoria about 1860. Carl Wilhelm Heberle (b 1846) from Hannover, arrived in Victoria in about 1870. Wilhelm Heberle, wife Hilda, Arthur b 1939 and Karl b 1946, from Rottenburg am Neckar, arrived in South Australia in 1952. Gertrud Frieda Heberle from Baden Baden, arrived in South Australia in 1955.

NEW SOUTH WALES (S.E. of Australia) c4 Heberles (1994) The first Heberles to settle in NSW were some of the South Australian miners who moved to Broken Hill around 1886. There were about 20 Heberles in Broken Hill between 1886 and 1900, but none after 1958. There is now only one Heberle family in N.S.W., the family of Kenneth (a descendant of August Friedrich) and Rhonda Heberle. Early Heberle records include Broken Hill 1886, Manley 1915, North Ryde 1975, North Rocks 1980, Forster Keys 1990, and Surry Hills 1994.

SOUTH AUSTRALIA (Central S. of Australia) c10 Heberles (1994) The first Heberles were in South Australia in 1851. About 85% of the Australian Heberles are descendants of August Friedrich Heberle, a miner from Clausthal-Zellerfeld (now Lower Saxony in Germany), who arrived in Adelaide, with his wife Caroline and 5 children in 1851. The family settled initially in a mining area east of Adelaide, possibly near Mt Barker. They moved to the Burra mining area (Kooringa-Redruth) in the mid 1850s and to Moonta in the late 1860s. Most of the family moved to Broken Hill NSW in 1886 and from there some moved to West Australia and Victoria, or back to South Australia, mainly in the 1890s. Early Heberle records include Burra 1856, Moonta 1867, Adelaide 1880, Hahndorf 1890, Point Turton 1909, Orroroo 1910, Hawthorn 1923, Cockburn 1933, Port Pirie 1941, Blanchetown 1947, Glenelg 1952, Medindie Gardens 1955, Marino 1957, Seaview Downs 1983.

VICTORIA (S.E. of Australia) c12 Heberles (1994) Carl August F Heberle (b Hannover Germany 1837) and his wife Augusta Henrietta (b 1840 Hannover) were farming in the Huntly area near Bendigo, in the 1860s. One of August Friedrich's sons, Frederick, settled in Melbourne in about 1886. The descendants of his son Harry Bellett, live in the Myrtleford-Tawonga area.

Early Heberle records include Huntly 1861, Eaglemont 1875, Coburg 1875, South Melbourne 1886, Glenhuntly 1912, Elsternwick 1916, Brunswick 1923, Ballarat 1930, Wangaratta 1937, Myrtleford 1949, Preston 1964, Falls creek 1971, Tawonga 1977, Mt Beauty 1985.

WEST AUSTRALIA (W. third of Australia) c29 Heberles (1994) August Frederick Heberle junior (b 1852 S.A.), wife Eliza, children Harold Percy (b 1882 S.A.), Elsie (b 1885 S.A.), Leslie (b 1889 N.S.W.) and five step children arrived in W.A. from Broken Hill N.S.W. in 1898 and settled in Perth. Descendants live in Albany, Geraldton, Gnowangerup, Katanning and Perth. Early Heberle records include Northam 1898, York 1901, Wembley 1906, Victoria Park 1915, Claremont 1924, East Perth 1925, Leederville 1926, North Perth 1927, Esperance 1932, Kalgoorlie 1932, Katanning 1938, Albany 1958, Tuart Hill 1965, Manjimup 1968, Hilton Park 1968, Harvey 1970, Port Hedland 1972, Geraldton 1974, Gnowangerup 1974, Medina 1976, Balcatta 1980, Bunbury 1980, Rockingham 1989.

14.2 U.S.A (Major language: English)

HAWAII c7 Heberles (1996) First European missionaries 1820. Annexed by USA 1898. U.S.State 1959. The Heberle families in Hawaii probably came from mainland U.S.A. since 1970.

14.3 NEW ZEALAND (Major languages: English, Maori) c2 Heberles 1994

SOUTH ISLAND In 1994 there was a Petra Heberle living in Dunedin, family history unknown. She may have come from Germany in the 1980's or 1990's. Beatrix Heberle of Stockach or Heidelberg (Germany) lived in New Zealand in 1996.

14.4 PHILIPPINES (Major languages: Philipino, English, Spanish) nil Heberles 1995

Internet data shows that there is a Heberle Beanavitz family in the Philippines.

14.5 ELSEWHERE IN OCEANIA

There could be Heberles in former French, German or Dutch colonies in Oceania.

15. WELL KNOWN HEBERLES

1600s

- According to M. - Hans Heberlin, landlord of Altusried in Bavaria, Germany was invested with the title of count on 30.10.1642 and is believed to have adopted the coat of arms depicted in section 7. The Heberle spelling of the family name was adopted in the 1680s.
